### Protection Prayers

The above *suras* of the Qur'an are read for both physical and spiritual protection from Satan, black magic, *envy* and jealousy.

Every morning, before leaving one's home, ***Sura Al Ikhlas*** should be recited thrice, ***Sura Al Falaq*** once, ***Sura Al Naas*** once and ***Fatiha*** once with the intention of protection.

Al Qadr	The Power

<b>Al Kawthar</b>	<b>The Drink of Paradise</b>

Surely, We have given you the <i>Kawthar</i>.</li> <li>2. So make your connection to your <i>Rab</i> [Lord], and offer sacrifice.</li> <li>3. Surely, it is your accuser (and not you) who is the one whose lineage is cut off.</li> </ol>

<b>Al Nasr</b>	<b>The Help</b>
<p><b>Bismillahir Rahmanir Rahim</b></p> <p><b>1. Izaa jaa-a nasrullahi wal fat-hu,</b></p> <p><b>2. Wa ra-aytan-naasa yadkhuluna fi dinillahi afwaaja.</b></p> <p><b>3. Fa-sabbih bi Hamdi Rabbika wastaghfir. Innahu kaana tawaba.</b></p>	<p>In the name of Allah, The One Who Acts with Mercy, The Source of Mercy.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. When Allah's help comes to you, and the triumph,</li> <li>2. And when you see human beings entering the <i>din</i> [practice of acting with the truth] of Allah in multitudes,</li> <li>3. Then do <i>tasbih</i> [repeated glorification] of your <i>Rab</i> [Lord] with gratitude and praise, and seek His absolution. Truly, He has always been ready to accept <i>tawba</i> [repentance].</li> </ol>
