## 1. DESTUR

#### 1. PERMISSION

(Everyone turns to face the Qibla. Shaykh places right toe over left toe; right fist over heart and guides everyone to say **HU**) Shaykh says the following aloud:

Destur ya Allah. Destur ya Rasulullah. Destur ya Ali Waliyul Allah. Destur ya Qutbul Zaman. Destur ya Sahibel Meydan. Please grant permission O Allah.
Please grant permission, O Rasulullah.
Please grant permission O Ali Wali of Allah.
Please grant us permission, Qutbul Zaman.
Please grant permission, Sahibel Meydan.

## 2. AL FATIHA

## 2. THE OPENING SURA

(The group says out loud along with the Shaykh.)

Allahumma salli a'la Sayyidina Muhammedin wa a'la ali Sayyidina Muhammad. Our God, send honor upon our Leader Muhammad and upon his family.

In the name of Allah who is Rahman [The

Shaykh directs dervishes to sit down in a circle, men on right, women on left.

Shaykh making rabita says silently to him or herself the medet to silsila:

Shaykh leads everyone to recite: Al Fatiha

Checking to see if everyone is paying attention Shaykh begins to lead Zikr:

Movement: Pendulum (Note to Shaykh: to stop each zikr say **illallah** and repeat the following at the end of each

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(Shaykh says before Estaughfirallah zikr: Ya ayyuhal-ladzhina amanu, tubu ilallahi taw-batan nasuha.

O Allah, please clean our hearts of everything but You.

Movement: Pendulum

Shaykh leads: Estaughfirallah, tubtu ilallah, wa na haytu qalbi a'n ma siwallah.

I seek forgiveness from Allah. I turn in repentance to Allah, and please clean my heart of everything that is not Allah.

8. Movement: Pendulum Shaykh changes zikr to: **Estaughfirallah** (fast)

## 9. PEACE UPON PROPHET MUHAMMAD

Shaykh recites before Salawat upon Prophet Muhammad: (English or Arabic)

A'edzhu billahi minash-shaytan'ir-rajim. Bis-millah'ir-Rahman'ir-rahim. Inna allaha wal mala-ikatahu yusalluna a'lannabiyyi. Ya ayyu-hal-ladzhina amanu, sallu a'laihi wa sallimu tesli-ma.

I seek refuge in Allah from Shaytan the banished. In the name of Allah who is *Al Rahman* [source of Mercy] and *Al Rahim* [one who acts with Mercy]. Allah the most High says in Quran-i-Karim that Allah and His angels shower their peace and blessings upon the Prophet. So you do the same.

Movement: Pendulum Shaykh leads Salawat:

Allah humma salli a'la sayyidina Muhammedin wa a'la alihi wa-sahbi hi wa sallim O Lord, send honor upon our leader Muhammad and on his family and companions, and peace.

Shaykh leads everyone to recite: Al Fatiha Shaykh says:

Allah the Most High says in Qurani-Karim: This Nur is found in the houses where Allah has allowed His praise to be done through zikr in the morning and in the evening. (Nur, 36)

Everyone makes sejda to the light in the middle and says **Hu**.

# 12. KALIMAT AL TAWHID

Shaykh checks to see if everyone is ready by making eye contact and says: **Qala men la ilaha ila Hu** 

He or she then leads congregation into next zikr.

Movement: Circular head movement

12. BEARING WITNESS OF ALLAH'S ONENESS

Say with the words of Allah.

There is no God but Allah.

(Congregation moves head in circular motion beginning with head bent to the right "la ila," then up to center "ha," then down to left "illallah". Continuing the downward momentum, the participant will close the circle by bringing the head back to the right

and repeat.)

13. Shaykh changes zikr to, jahri (in Turkish,

cehri, meaning louder) zikr.

Movement: Triangulation, sitting

La ilaha illallah

These ilahis are sung and in this order:

Yüzün Nuru Hudadir Seyreyleyip Yandim Abdul Qadir ül Geylani 13. There is no God but Allah.

(Still in sitting position, the congregation moves upper body over right knee "la", back to center "ila", over left knee "hailla", then back to center "llah.")

Shaykh says: Allah says in Quran-i Karim, and there are believers who remember me sitting, standing and reclining, and look into the space and contemplate and say, "O Lord, you haven't created all this for nothing. All praise belongs to you. Please protect us from the torment of fire."

Shaykh directs everyone to stand up.

## 14. ALLAH ZIKR

Everyone is standing and Shaykh leads in singing **Sirni Ala** 

Movement: Hazreti Hajar Zikr

Shaykh transitions to Allah Allah Allah Allah zikr

Movement: Wheatfield Zikr

This ilahi is sung: Güzel Aşık

Movement: Silat Move

These ilahis are sung: Iki Kere Gavs Oldu Mevlam Nurdan Yaratmış

Movement: Ski pole

These ilahis are sung: Can Yine Bülbül Oldu Canı Dilden Fani

Movement: Sema

# 14. ALLAH ZIKR

(Hazreti Hajar Zikr: Now standing, congregation joins in the song's refrain slowly swaying right with hands and palms uplifted "Allahhh," then to left with hands and palms uplifted "Allahhh," then again to right, then left. Total 4x each refrain.)

(Wheatfield Zikr: Congregation transitions to a slightly quicker and constant swaying or turning right "Allah" and left "Allah" with arms down by side. One cycle is, Right "Allahh," Left "Allahh," Right "Allahh," Left "Allahh-a," Right "Allahh," Left "Allahh," Right "Allahh," Left "Allah." Repeat)

Movement: Ski pole

Shaykh goes around to each participant, repeating HU to each, giving each one energy (mugabbila).

19. Shaykh leads **Hu** fast.

19. Thou/He/She/It

Movement: Ski pole.

Shaykh sings the following as congregation

repeats Hu:

Es salatu wa salamu a'leyke ya

(congregation says this last line in unison with the Shaykh)

Shaykh says: Al Fatiha.

(Shaykh may direct another person say Al **Fatiha** here and everyone recites it.) Shaykh guides everyone to sit down.

*Personal* **Dua** *and* **Zikr** *for supplication to the* world, Shaykh assists with determining appropriate zikr to recite.

The Shaykh finishes with a longer dua for the world and more repetitions of Allah's Names

Each person says a short prayer invoking two of the Names of Allah

stand up and face Qiblah. Shaykh leads everyone to say **Hu** as he

Shukran ya Ali Waliyul Allah. Shukran ya Qutbul Zaman. Shukran ya Sahibel Meydan. Prostrate and then stand up

Thank you O Allah Thank you O Rasulullah Thank you O Ali Wali of Allah Thank you O Qutbul Zaman Thank you O Sahibel Meyhdan

Shaykh leads everyone to recite Al Fatiha

The Opening Sura

23. SALAM

Shaykh says: Bismi Dhate Allah.

Congregation responds with: HU.

23. SENDING GREETINGS & PEACE

Shaykh says; With the essence of Allah's name. May Allah's peace be upon you

Shaykh: As Salam alaykum

Congregation responds with Wa alaykum as Salam wa rahmatullah wa barakatahu

Congregation responds with: and on you Allah's peace, mercy and blessings.

Shaykh says: Takbir! (3 times).

Congregation responds: Allahu Akbar! (3

times).

Zikr is finished.

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
